1. How do I access Cengage, Hawkes, Jones & Bartlett, Pearson, Sage, and McGrawHill in my Canvas?

If your instructor is using Mindtap or Webassign, you will find your course level link in Modules. If your instructor is only using the ebook, you will find that in the Learning Materials link in Canvas.

Navigate to the Modules tab of your Canvas course and select Hawkes Single Sign On from within the Hawkes Learning Module. You can also navigate to the Assignments tab of your Canvas course and select an individual Hawkes assignment to access Hawkes directly.

Use the My Textbooks link in your Canvas course navigation.

A deep link is created in Canvas that takes students/instructors directly into the Sage Vantage courseware.

2. I can't find the Cengage, Hawkes, Jones & Bartlett, Pearson, Sage, and McGrawHill link in my Canvas course. What should I do?

3. How do I link my Canvas and Cengage, Hawkes, Jones & Bartlett, Pearson, Sage, and McGrawHill accounts?

For Mindtap and Webassign, you will click the course level link your instructor provided. The very first time you click this link, you will either log in to an existing Cengage account or you will create an account. Every other time after this, clicking the course level link will automatically launch you into the platform.

This will happen automatically through the account creation process the first time you access Hawkes through Canvas.

Use the My Textbooks link, follow the steps and you will be prompted for your Pearson credentials. The instructor should also have a guide that shows this process. See answer for #2
